

INSTALLATION OF QCMS

WARNING: If you already have QCMS installed on your computer do not use this installation. The installation will extract data files that will overwrite your existing data files.

To upgrade to the current version of QCMS, use the `qcupdate.exe` installation as shown below at the end of this file after the
title: Updating QCMS

Only one disk is required to install QCMS on your hard drive.
This disk will contain the `QCSETUP.EXE` file.

Step 1: Edit your `Config.sys` files:

For Windows 95/98: Go to the root directory of C drive (`C:\>`). Use the DOS editor and edit your `config.sys` file (`C:\>EDIT CONFIG.SYS`). Find the command line that reads `FILES = xxx`. If the number shown here as `xxx` is greater than or equal to 81, then you're set to go. If the number is less than 81, then type in 81. If there is no command line `FILES=xxx`, then add this line (i.e., `FILES = 81`) anywhere BELOW the
Upper Memory Manager Device Driver
(eg, `DEVICE=C:\DOS`). Type ALT F, and then
to exit. When prompted whether to save the loaded
file, enter y for yes and the C prompt will now reappear.

For Windows NT: Go to the folder `c:\winnt\system32` (`C:\>WINNT\SYSTEM32`) Use the DOS editor and edit your
`config.nt` file (`C:\>EDIT CONFIG.NT`). Find the
command line that reads `FILES = xxx`. If the number shown
