


## SpecsIntact 3 Overview

SpecsIntact 3 is different from previous versions of SpecsIntact because it is now a 32-bit program designed to run on Windows 95 and above. What that means to you, the user, is that you now have available many of the features you've become familiar with when using other Windows-based programs. Previous limitations regarding Working Directories and managing Jobs by dragging and dropping files are gone.

This program takes the functions formerly found in three modules -- **Setup, Jobs and Masters** -- and combines them into the new SpecsIntact Explorer.



When you open SpecsIntact 3, the Explorer screen will display automatically. From its menus and toolbar, you will be able to create, process and print your Jobs and Masters. Editing the Sections of your Jobs and Masters can be accomplished in the SpecsIntact Editor (which remains unchanged from previous versions) or in WordSpec, which is now a built-in feature rather than a separate product.

Compatibility of Jobs and Masters with software versions:

- You must use v.3.1 or newer for Jobs or Masters containing the UFGS six-digit Section names, which are not compatible with any older versions of the software, including v. 3.0.

- You must use v2.9.5 or newer for Jobs or Masters with the Unified Submittal Descriptions.
- Any Job or Master created with v2.9.4 or older can be edited in subsequent versions of the software, but new Sections containing the Unified SD numbers or the UFGS six-digit Section names cannot be added to them.
